

What's New in ERP V14.0.3

ERP-802	Power Writer	Power Writer Report Run	An issue was identified when running a Power Writer report with multiple Stages selected. When two or more Stages are selected for the same report run, the second selected Stage is ignored, resulting in incomplete or incorrect report results. The reporting engine has been updated to ensure all selected stages are correctly processed and included in the output.
ERP-778	Job Costing	Progress Claims - Task Based Claims	We have identified an issue where changes made to the Progress Claim task columns can be overwritten when task details are maintained via Job Details > Task. A software update has been made to ensure that changes made to the Progress Claim task column settings and Job Details > Task TAB are maintained separately, preventing configuration loss during maintenance.

ERP-762	Payroll	Contribution Maintenance	An enhancement has been made to the Contribution Maintenance functionality to introduce the concept of Master Contributions. This is designed to reduce administration and improve consistency when maintaining Super Contributions where multiple records share the same configuration. • Master Contribution: Acts as the primary record for common settings. • Child Contributions: Can be associated with the Master to inherit settings. This reduces the need to maintain identical settings across numerous individual records. For further details, please refer to the online Help manual.
ERP-755	Payroll	Payroll Standard Timesheets	An issue has been identified where the column settings for Standard Timesheets and Payroll Timesheets were not being kept in sync for Work Types and Allowances tables. The column settings functionality has been updated to ensure that both screens use consistent column arrangements, ensuring a uniform user experience across different timesheet entry points.
ERP-745	Payroll	Payroll Timesheet	The software has been updated to ensure that Salary Sacrifice (SALSAC) amounts are retained when editing the associated Work Type on the Payroll Timesheet. Changing the hours or other details on the Work Type will no longer incorrectly reset the SALSAC Total to zero, ensuring payroll accuracy during manual adjustments.
ERP-719	Job Costing	Job Transaction Enquiry windows	An enhancement has been made to the Job Detail Transactions TAB by adding new Hours (HRS) and Hourly Cost (\$) columns for transaction type 'TS'. These additions improve visibility of labour and timesheet-related transaction information, allowing users to better reconcile labour costing against jobs and cost codes. These columns have also been added to the Job Transaction Search for consistency.
ERP-698	Payroll	Payroll timesheet	Resolved an issue in both Standard Timesheets and Payroll Timesheets where the Contribution percentage was not displayed when adding a new Contribution row. The percentage is now displayed immediately upon selection, without requiring the timesheet to be saved and refreshed.
